Authority **This Rule and Regulation is promulgated pursuant to Phoenix City Code, Chapter IV, Article IV, Section 4-71.**

Rule and Regulation **Schedule of Penalties**

The purpose of this Rule and Regulation is to assist Aviation Department management representatives with the enforcement of violations of Article IV, Phoenix City Code by providing a Schedule of Penalties.

General Management representatives in Operations are authorized to issue Notices of Penalty for violations of Article IV, Phoenix City Code. To ensure consistency in imposing penalties, the following schedule of penalties is a guideline to be used by the management representatives:

NOTICE OF PENALTY – ALLOCATION BY POINTS:

Accumulated Points	Penalty
20	5 day suspension
40	15 day suspension
60	30 day suspension
80	60 day suspension

Each subsequent 20 points accumulated after 80 points will result in additional increments of 60-day suspensions.

Severe violations will receive a 180-day suspension or revocation of permit (an example of a severe violation may include but is not limited to; possession of an illegal firearm, road rage, possession of an illegal substance, alcohol abuse, or assault, etc.)

A violation of any provision of Article IV, Phoenix City Code by any driver or vehicle owner shall also constitute a violation of such provision by the ground transportation business if the same driver or owner has had **three (3) or more Notices of Penalty issued within the previous 36 months.**

Not taking most direct route to destination	10

Non-designated parking	20
Non-designated loading of passengers	20
Fare refusal	20
Unauthorized soliciting of passengers / Scooping	20

Severe Violations	Points
Possession of an illegal firearm	Revocation
Road Rage	Revocation
Possession of an illegal substance	Revocation
Alcohol abuse	Revocation
Assault	Revocation

Note that this Rule and Regulation is intended to supplement, and not amend, repeal or supersede the provisions of Article IV of Chapter 4 of the Phoenix City Code.
