Authority:

This Rule and regulation is promulgated pursuant to City Code Chapter IV. Article 111. Vehicle Operation or Parking: and Pedestrian Traffic Regulation Section 4-49 (A).

Rule and Regulations:

Runway and Taxiway Safety Area Training

No individual will be allowed into the runway and taxiway safety areas unless they have been certified to operate in the area or are escorted by an individual who is certified.

In order to receive certification, an individual must successfully complete the Aviation Department Runway and Taxiway Safety Area Training Course. The Operations Division will administer the program. This course will combine classroom study and testing with familiarization rides. At its conclusion, a series of certification rides will be administered. A person, who successfully completes the certification rides, will be issued an airfield driver's permit number beginning with the letter "A" indicating that the person is certified to operate in the safety area. A 100% score is required to pass the certification ride.

Roles and Responsibilities:


The Aviation Department conducts runway and safety area training classes, tests applicants and issues driver permits.


Anyone who operates any type of motorized vehicle/equipment in the runway and taxiway safety areas of the airfield is required to first attend the training class, take familiarization rides, pass the written test, and pass night and day check rides.

Notification

The Deputy Aviation Director - Operations or his designee must be notified prior to any activity taking place in the safety areas. Clearance must also be obtained from the air traffic control tower. References and Definitions Runway and Taxiway Safety Area Training Handbook.
