### WHAT IS A SMALL BUSINESS?

The City of Phoenix defines eligible small business firms as:

- Independent and for-profit business concerns
- Owned and controlled by one or more persons
  - Personal Net Worth (PNW) of each owner(s) cannot exceed \$2.047 million
  - Gross sales (averaged over the business' previous 5 fiscal years) cannot exceed the Small Business
    Administration (SBA) guidelines









## **BENEFITS OF CERTIFICATION**

- Visibility/Exposure
  - Primes
  - Other "small" business
  - Private sector
  - Other municipalities
- Increased access to opportunities
- Growth





## **CERTIFICATION TERMINOLOGY**

AVN = City of Phoenix Aviation Department "system" which includes Phoenix Sky Harbor International, Phoenix Goodyear, and Phoenix Deer Valley airports

**ACDBE** = Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise

Program implemented by local agencies pursuant to federal regulations, Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations Part 23 (49 CFR Part 23). This program applies to contracts and concessions administered by airports that receive financial assistance from the Federal Aviation Administration.

### **DBE** = Disadvantaged Business Enterprise

Program implemented by local agencies and state departments of transportation pursuant to federal regulations 49 CFR Part 26. This program applies to all contracts financed in whole or in part by the Federal Aviation Administration, Federal Transit Administration or Federal Highway Administration.

### **SBE** = Small Business Enterprise

Program implemented by the City of Phoenix to promote small business development. Only applicants who meet the certification requirements set forth in Chapter 18, Article VIII of the Phoenix City Code Eligibility requirements for SBE certification will be certified.



## **CERTIFICATION TERMINOLOGY**

**Local program** = SBE Program implemented by the **City of Phoenix City Code Chapter 18** to promote small business development and applies to contracts issued by the City of Phoenix.

**USDOT** = The United States Department of Transportation (USDOT or DOT) is a federal agency of the U.S. government responsible for transportation.

**FAA** = Federal Aviation Administration

**AZUCP** = Arizona Unified Certification program. A "one-stop" program created to allow an applicant for DBE Certification in Arizona to file only one application and go through one certification review to achieve DBE Certification that will be recognized by all recipients of FAA, FHWA and FTA funds in the State.

**Certification** = Granted approval of \*DBE, ACDBE or SBE application by the City of Phoenix ( \*AZUCP).

**SEDO** = Socially and Economically Disadvantage Owner

**JOC** = Jurisdiction of Original Certification. (Formally Home State)

### FEDERAL PROGRAMS

### **Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE)**

### Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) \*

- Applicable to USDOT-funded contracts administered by the City or its subrecipients (Valley Metro and 15 surrounding cities)
- Available to firms located throughout the United States. ٠
  - Applicants in **Arizona** can apply/complete the City of Phoenix, ADOT, or City of Tucson DBE certification process.
  - Applicants from **another state** must be certified in their <u>JOC</u> and can apply with the City of Phoenix (AC/DBE) or ADOT (DBE).




### CITY OF PHOENIX CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS

### LOCAL PROGRAM

Small Business Enterprise (SBE)

- Applicable to City of Phoenix-funded contracts administered by the City (opportunity to "Do Business" with the City of Phoenix)
- Available <u>only</u> to firms whose principal place of business is located in Maricopa County





## AC/DBE vs SBE CERTIFICATION

## There are **similarities** between **AC/DBE** and **SBE** certification for owners

- Personal Net Worth
- Control and Expertise
- US Citizenship or permanent legal resident
- Operational For-Profit concern
- Small Business Administration (SBA) guidelines requirement
- Non-transferrable
- Business size
  - Same for DBE and SBE but <u>not</u> for ACDBE

## SBE PROGRAM




## Program is race and gender neutral.

Firm need not be owned or controlled by a particular ethnic or gender group to apply.



## **DIFFERENCES: LOCATION**



Can be located anywhere in U.S. but must complete the DBE certification process in Arizona. Jurisdiction of Original Certification (JOC) is required for interstate certification.

Firm must have its principal location in Maricopa County.

  - Certification granted If denied, applicant can appeal decision

## TO CHANGE or ADD\* A NAICS CODE

\*Only applies to certified firms

NAICS codes are determined by the scope(s) of work in which a firm meets certification standards. It is **crucial** to ensure that your firm is assigned the correct NAICS codes because it establishes what your firm can be "counted" for utilization credits.

- 1. Review your current NAICS Code classifications associated with your certification. Make sure you have been assigned all of the appropriate classifications for your firm.
- 2. If the appropriate codes are not listed, you can request at add or delete NAICS codes via the **online application portal: https://phoenix.diversitycompliance.com**

You will need to provide **documentation of capacity** to establish that your firm performs work in the additional classifications requested by providing:

- Past or current contracts
- Evidence of activity specific (i.e., new license or equipment)
- Other information as directed by EOD

Certifications do not lapse or expire.

**However**, firms are required to submit via the online system a **Declaration of Eligibility**\* annually which confirms the firm's circumstances have not changed and is still eligible to maintain S/DBE certification.

The online system sends reminders:

- 60 days prior to the anniversary date of your certification
- Every **2 weeks** until you submit the paperwork

Owners failing to submit required renewal documentation in a timely manner are considered **non-compliant** and their firms may be **decertified**. You will receive a separate "Notice of Intent to Remove" by email, to which you must respond immediately to prevent any further action.

### COMMON MISTAKES DURING THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Incomplete information
- Insufficient documentation of ownership acquisition
- By-Laws/Operating Agreement issues
- Insufficient management, control, and/or voting rights
- Lack of independence
